Accessibility

The building is all on one level and suitable for wheelchairs and pushchairs. Disabled-access toilets and baby changing facilities are available. Subject to availability a manual wheelchair is available for use, free of charge while visiting the aquarium. Disabled toilets are situated both at reception and in our Wild Solway Exhibition Centre. There are several pay and display parking bays by the entrance to the aquarium, reserved for disabled customers. Our cafe and gift shop is located on the ground floor and is accessible without purchase of admission ticket.

Harbourside Café

Our café is part of the aquarium building but like the gift shop, mini golf and boat pool is accessible to the general public, not just ticket holders. The location is amazing, with views overlooking the harbour and out across the Solway to Scotland on clear days. If the weather allows there are picnic tables and a patio, allowing us to seat 60+ customers at any one time so we can cope with coaches on all but the busiest days. There is a great cup of coffee too. We have lots of regulars dropping in for a cappuchino and fresh scone! We are a non-smoking facility, accessible to wheelchairs, and there are high chairs for infants.
